About Scheiblhofer

The Winery Scheiblhofer is located in Andau which is part of the administrative district Neusiedl am See. With its owned 85 hectares of vineyards Scheiblhofer is one of the biggest wineries in Burgenland. The company is famous for its red wine cuvée “Big John”. The winery was founded by Johann Scheiblhofer in 1983 and taken over by his son Erich in 2000. Besides the production of high-quality wines, the family business focuses on modernity, innovation, sustainability and interpersonal skills.

Scheiblhofer was Austria’s first winemaker who received the Austria’s Leading Companies-Certificate. Furthermore, they were awarded as the “Best Family Business of Burgenland” in May 2017 by the daily newspaper “die Presse”, Bankhaus Spängler, BDO Austria and the Austrian Chamber of Notary. Also, the Chamber of Agriculture of Burgenland announced Scheiblhofer as Winery of the Year.

The winery Scheiblhofer is seen as a pioneer concerning sustainability and has been self-sufficient in terms of energy since years. This is possible because of a photovoltaic system on the company’s rooftops, which is the biggest private one of Burgenland (280 kWp). In addition, the winery has already been equipped with electric cars and a charging station.

With 3000 oak barrels (the so called “Barriques”) Scheiblhofer is the winery with the most barrels in the country. The company is also an important employer of the region and a supporter of many social initiatives. Further, the winery is known as an attractive hot spot for visitors. The company’s success definitely relies on the commitment of its employees and the family’s support.
